Heather was diagnosed with an aggressive rare cancer her oncologist states that it is the likes of MMT (Malignant Mixed Müllerian tumor) . Heather has undergone chemotherapy and radiation treatment previously. Her next step is to undergo further intensive chemotherapy (2 kinds) for 3 rounds every 21 days. She will then receive another CT Scan to find out the next step which is expected to be surgery or further chemotherapy.
